Recycling Sorting - Changes



You may have seen the leaflet "Five Steps to Pre-sorted Recycling" about how to sort out your recyclables for collection. There are a couple changes to the way the recycling should be sorted out which should be noted.

1. Tins/cans and aerosols should now go in the white sack along with the plastic bottles, food trays, yoghurt pots etc. and not the black boxes.
2. Ideally use one black box for papers and magazines and a second box for glass bottles and jars. For more containers ring 01285 623123. If you don't want two boxes put the papers at one end and the glass at the other.

A40 Evening & Overnight Road Closure



The A40 in Dowdeswell will be closed overnight for surface repairs between the hours of 7pm and 7am.

The dates are yet to be finalised but the current option is sometime between 30th August to 11th September. These dates have already been changed twice so for the latest proposed dates see this link:

The section of road to be closed is roughly where the road runs adjacent to the reservoir. i.e. traveling towards Cheltenham, from the bottom of Tunnel Hill by the turning to Dowdeswell to a point near the Cheltenham end of the reservoir before you get to Koloshi.

The official diversion is via the A40 to the Frogmill, the A436 to Seven Springs, then the A435 Cirencester Road & Holy Apostles Church and back on the A40 to Six Ways etc.
