RULES FOR EXHIBIT ENTRY, JUDGING & RECLAIM AT END OF SHOW

Whilst the primary aim of the Show for Sevenhampton, Charlton Abbotts and Hawling Parishes is to provide a relaxed environment and fun day for everyone to enjoy, we do need to have some rules which will help us run the Produce and Exhibition entries and competition in an orderly way. Please take a little time to study and understand the rules should you wish to enter.

All proceeds go to the Show Fund and are used for the benefit of the Community in the Parishes concerned.

Entry Form and Fees

- 1. All entries to be on Official Entry Forms. Entries & fees to be with the **Show Secretary, Ray Oldham,** at Rose Cottage, Brockhampton, **by Wednesday 21**st **August 2019 without fail (Except Section 8: 'On the Day' Entry)**.
- 2. The entry fees are 30p for each entry in Classes 1 to 60 and 20p for Classes 65 to 74. Exhibitors may only enter once for each class; no second entry. Entry fees will be forfeited if the exhibitor enters a class but then fails to submit an entry.
- 3. Exhibitors must deliver their entry/entries to the Village Hall in Brockhampton between 6.00 and 6.30 pm on Friday 23rd August or between 7.30 and 9.30 am on Saturday 24th August. **After this deadline, no exhibits will be accepted.** Section 8 entries must be submitted at the Show Marquee by 9.30am on Show day. Entry fee: 50p.

Exhibits and Judging

- 4. All adult exhibitors must be resident in these parishes or be a Friend of the Show with fully paid up membership. All junior exhibitors (16 or under on the day of the Show) must be resident in or have a relative who is resident in one of the parishes or who is a Friend of the Show.
- 5. All entries must be the work of the exhibitor.
- 6. All pot plants must be in the exhibitor's possession for a minimum of 60 days prior to the Show.
- 7. Two or more persons may not exhibit separately from the same garden or allotment in any one Class in Sections 1 & 2.
- 8. All exhibits entered must be made or grown by the exhibitors themselves (unless specifically stated otherwise against the class). All produce should be grown by exhibitors in their own gardens or allotments. Should a complaint arise in this respect, the Committee reserve the right to investigate the complaint and if the complaint is upheld, then the exhibitor will be disqualified.
- 9. Entries in Sections 5 & 6 will not be accepted if previously exhibited in this Show.
- 10. If, in the opinion of the Judges, exhibits in a particular prize category are not of sufficient merit or quality, then the prize for that category may not be awarded.
- 11. The Committee will not be held responsible for any loss or damage incurred, but reasonable care will be taken of all exhibits.
- 12. Any complaint must be made in writing and signed by the objector by 4pm on the day of the Produce Show and accompanied by a £5 fee. The £5 fee will be forfeited should the Committee consider that the objection is unfounded or frivolous. Any complaints received in accordance with the above will be dealt with by the Committee only.
- 13. The Committee reserves the right to interpret the rules and alter times shown.
- 14. The Committee's decision shall be final.

Exhibit Auction and Reclaim

- 15. No exhibit is to be removed before 3.35pm on the day. All exhibitors are requested to leave as many exhibits as possible for sale at the Show Auction. Exhibits will be removed for auction at 3.45pm unless clearly marked 'NOT FOR SALE'. All those so marked will be left in the Hall and not be auctioned.
- 16. Exhibits that are 'NOT FOR SALE' and all plates or containers used for exhibits are to be removed from the Village Hall by 5.00pm on Show day; otherwise they will be disposed of/thrown away.
