12. A 'lock down' limerick*
13. A three verse poem "we are all partaking in the Virtual Show"*
14. A photo of my longest home grown runner bean next to a ruler

Village Treasure Hunt

Get your clues sheet from Sue Tallents (suetallents@me.com) from 22nd August, then have fun exploring Brockhampton & Sevenhampton villages, solving clues and learning a bit of local history. You can take part in the Treasure Hunt on 27th, 28th & 29th August. It's 3.5 miles long; should take 2-2.5 hours & can be done in separate sections. For all ages.

How to Enter Classes

Classes are open to all residents of the 3 Parishes, and to Friends of the Show. The Junior Classes are open to those aged 16 and under on the day of the Show, who live in any of the three Parishes (Sevenhampton, Charlton Abbotts & Hawling) or are staying with relatives or Friends of the Show who live here.

- Juniors can enter all 19 classes; adults can enter classes 1-15
- There's a single Entry Fee of £5 to enter as many classes as you like. You may have a maximum of two entries in each class
- Pay the Entry Fee direct to "Sevenhampton Brockhampton Show", Sort Code: 30-91-87 Account No: 01218287. Put your name as reference. Or pay by cheque/cash, handed to the Secretary
- Photos/entries to be emailed or hand delivered to Ray Oldham, Secretary by 12 noon on Monday 24th August. Email address: showsecretary2020@outlook.com Address: Rose Cottage, Brockhampton
- Submissions should include: name; address; email address; contact number; classes entered and age group (Junior Classes!). Photos should be jpegs (not pdf's)
- The Secretary will provide you with your Competitor Number & will load your photos (all classes except 1-3;6 & 18) onto 'flickr'
- Photos, poems and limericks will go live on 'flickr' on Friday 28th August at 9am. You will be emailed a link beforehand
- Judging of the gardens and scarecrows will take place on Friday 28th August
- Virtual judging of the other classes will take place after Monday 24th deadline
- The Challenge Cups (Trophies) will be presented at the After Show Party, which we hope will be held in Brockhampton Village Hall early in the New Year
- There are cups for most classes (2 for Class 1 – winner & runner up). Some cups will be awarded to competitors who achieve the most points across several classes (e.g. 5&6; 7-11; 12&13; 16-19). Cups will be won by Juniors in each age class that win the most points across classes 16-19
- Please also consider becoming a Friend of the Show (see other flyer)
- Proceeds from the Show will help local good causes
