How to Enter the Classes

Classes are open to all residents of the 3 Parishes (4 Villages) and to the Friends of the Show.

Younger entrants: please include your age with your entry (if under 16 on the day of the Show) as there are trophies to win. You must live in any of the three Parishes or be staying with relatives or Friends of the Show who live here.

- There are no entry fees. You are allowed a maximum of two entries in each class
- Complete the list of classes (entry form below) you'd like to enter and email showsecretary2020@outlook.com or hand deliver to Ray Oldham, Secretary, Rose Cottage, Brockhampton, GL54 5XG (100 yards down from the telephone box on the right) by 12 noon Monday 16th August.
- Photos & Limericks (Classes 8-13) to be hand delivered to the Secretary by Wednesday 18th August
- Submissions should include the following: name; address; email address; contact number; classes entered & age (if under 16 on day of Show).
- Judging: Gardens on Friday 20th August and Classes 8-13 on the morning of Show Day
- Results of the Garden competitions will be posted in the Village Hall on Show Day
- The Challenge Cups (Trophies) will be presented at the Show prior to the Auction
- Please remove all photographic entries & limericks at the end of the Show; those not removed will be disposed of.
- As previous years, proceeds from the Show will help local good causes.
