Recipe (Class 4) - Ukranian Apple Cake (Yabluchnyk)

Ingredients: 180g plain flour ; 120g butter or margarine; 50g caster sugar; 1 beaten egg; 1/4 teaspoon salt; 5 tablespoons cream; 2 teaspoons baking powder; 3 or 4 apples (cooking or dessert), peeled, cored & thinly sliced Struesel Topping: 1 tablespoon cold butter or margarine; 45g soft brown sugar (light or dark); 1 tablespoon plain flour; 1 teaspoon cinnamon

Method: Preheat oven to 375F or 190C. Use an 8" or 9" square tin.

1. Lightly butter the cake tin; 2. Sift together the flour, sugar, salt & baking powder 3. Add butter & mix together to form a crumbly mixture 4. Add the egg & cream. Mix until it's a soft dough 5. Press into the prepared tin 6. Layer the apples on top, overlapping slightly

To make the Streusel topping: Mix together the sugar, flour and cinnamon. Add the butter and mix until a crumbly mixture is formed. Sprinkle over the apples. Bake until the apples have softened and the topping has browned, about 25 minutes.
