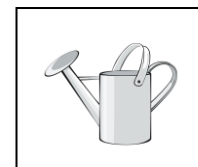

Wednesday 26th May. Evening visit to The Coach House, Ampney Crucis, Near Cirencester with introductory talk from its owner, Mel Tanner. The 1½ acre garden has ‘rooms’ with a rose garden, rill, herbaceous borders, green garden with pleached limes and a potager. The evening will finish with a pub supper, Covid restrictions permitting. (Own or shared transport). **£8.00 (approx.)**

Tuesday 22nd June. Coach trip to Jessica Dickinson’s Wortley House, Wotton-under-Edge. The twenty acres of garden include a walled garden, potager, lime avenues, nut walks, ponds, an Italian garden, wildflower meadows etc. Follies & statues enhance the vistas. Refreshments will be included at Wortley. Afterwards we hope to have a pub lunch (restrictions permitting) before visiting Hodges Barn Gardens, Shipton Moyne. Originally a 14th century Barn it has a large Arts & Crafts garden with hedges, topiary, water garden and woodland garden.
